TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS SHALL COME, Greeting:

Know ye, This is an Acknowledgment and Notice of Acknowledgment made under Utah Code § 72-5-309 through 310 inclusive that the grant of the United States of America of “the right of way for the construction of highways over public lands, not reserved for public uses” under United States Revised Statutes 2477 (43 U.S.C. § 932 (repealed October 21, 1976, with proviso recognizing the validity of rights-of-way already established)) was accepted for and on behalf of the State of Utah and its political subdivision Beaver County as it pertains to the highway located in Beaver County known as 5 MILE DAM ROAD; County Road Number: B-212; State Geographic Information Database (SGID) Road Identification Number: RD011215. Total road length is 1.26 miles more or less.


The reasons for this acknowledgment are as follows (indicated by an “X” in one or more blocks and any supplemental comment):
