



**AFFIDAVIT OF RICHARD D. ROCK**

Richard D. Rock, being first duly sworn, deposes and states as follows:

1. I am an adult competent to testify about the matters set forth below based upon my personal knowledge. I currently reside in Box Elder County, Utah. I have lived in Box Elder County 65 years. I have worked for the Box Elder County Road Department since 1963 and my father had worked for the road department many years before I started.

2. I have traveled and am familiar with a road in Box Elder County known as Goose Creek / Grouse Creek / Pilot Mountain Road. I am also familiar with the land the road traverses. When I first used and observed the road in 1960, it followed the same route as in 2005 when I last observed it. Attached is a Box Elder County map showing Goose Creek / Grouse Creek / Pilot Mountain Road. To the best of my knowledge and based upon my use of and familiarity with this road and the land it traverses, the location and route of the road are correctly illustrated on the attached map. The County also identifies this road according to the road number listed above.

3. I have observed that the road has been open to the public for all to use, to come and go as they pleased, since at least as early as 1960 and continuing through 1976 to 2005. I accompanied my father as he performed work on this road as early as 1960 and I have traveled and worked on it many times since. Throughout this time period I have observed travel on the road by various means, including all types of motor vehicles. Throughout this time period, the road has been used daily for more than ten continuous years prior to 1976, and is presently used daily.

4. Throughout the time period from 1960 to 2005, I have used the road myself for hunting and as a Box Elder County Road Department employee.

5. Throughout the time period described in the previous paragraph, I observed vehicles using the road at various times for the uses described in the previous paragraph, plus ranching, farming, hunting, sightseeing, recreation and traveling in and through the area.


6. It is also the reputation in the community that this road has been open to the public for all to use, to come and go as they pleased, since at least as early as 1960 and continuing through 1976 to the present, for the uses described in the previous paragraphs.

7. Prior to 1960, my father worked as part of the county road crew and helped construct a section of this road before I started working for the county. The road was maintained when I started with the road department and has been continually maintained at least several times a year since I have worked for the county. I have personally graded the road with a mechanized grader numerous times starting in 1970. In addition to grading, the road had culverts in place well before 1976.



