Know ye, This is an Acknowledgment and Notice of Acknowledgment made under Utah Code Sections 72-5-309 through 310 inclusive, that the grant of the United States of America of "the right of way for the construction of highways over public lands, not reserved for public uses" under United States Revised Statutes 2477 (43 U.S.C. Section 932 (repealed October 21, 1976, with proviso recognizing the validity of rights-of-way already established)) was accepted for and on behalf of the State of Utah and its political subdivision Carbon County as it pertains to the highway located in Carbon County known as GAS FIELD ROAD; County Road Number: 2782; State Geographic Information Database (SGID) Road Identification Number: RD040006. Total road length is 0.92 miles more or less.


