TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS SHALL COME, Greeting:

Know ye, This is an Acknowledgment and Notice of Acknowledgment made under Utah Code Sections 72-5-309 through 310 inclusive, that the grant of the United States of America of “the right of way for the construction of highways over public lands, not reserved for public uses” under United States Revised Statutes 2477 (43 U.S.C. Section 932 (repealed October 21, 1976, with proviso recognizing the validity of rights-of-way already established)) was accepted for and on behalf of the State of Utah and its political subdivision Grand County as it pertains to the highway located in Grand County known as BAKERS RESERVOIR ROAD; County Road Number: 00172; State Geographic Information Database (SGID) Road Identification Number: RD100066. Total road length is 2.02 miles more or less.

The reason for this Acknowledgment and Notice of Acknowledgment includes, but is not limited to, the fact that the road was constructed, mechanically, or by continuous use as a public highway for a period of at least ten years, over public lands not reserved for public uses, prior to the earlier of (a) the October 21, 1976 repeal of R.S. 2477 or (b) the date the servient estate was reserved for public uses.

This Acknowledgment and Notice of Acknowledgment applies only to the segments of the road that traverse land owned by the Bureau of Land Management, United States Department of the Interior, and does not apply to segments of the road that traverse land owned by any other person or entity. The State of Utah and its political subdivisions reserve the right to make further acknowledgments and notices of acknowledgment with regard to road segments that traverse land owned by other entities, including the United States of America, through one or more of its agencies.

A printed copy of a map showing the location of the road in said county is appended hereto as “Attachment 1,” a printed copy of representative photos of the road is appended hereto as “Attachment 2,” a printed copy of a description of the beginning and ending points of the entire road together with a list of Townships, Ranges and Sections that may be traversed by the road in said county is appended hereto as “Attachment 3,” and a printed copy of the Road Centerline Description Cover Page(s) is appended hereto as “Attachment 4.” The Appendices listed in “Attachment 4” that contain the actual road centerline descriptions are incorporated herein by reference. Affidavits provided by individuals familiar with the road are appended hereto as “Attachment 5.”

A printed copy of this Acknowledgment and Notice of Acknowledgment, together with its Attachments and Appendices, may be viewed and/or obtained at the office of the Utah State Archives.

An electronic copy of this Acknowledgment and Notice of Acknowledgment, together with its Attachments and Appendices, may be viewed and/or downloaded as read-only PDF (Portable Document Format) files via the



A claimant shall file a petition within sixty (60) days after receipt of this Notice.





WILLIAM W. CUNNINGHAM, being first duly sworn, deposes and states as follows:

1. I am an adult competent to testify about the matters set forth below based upon my personal knowledge. I have lived in Mesa County, Colorado since 1991. My family and I owned and lived on a ranch in Grand County, Utah from 1927 to 1991.

2. I have traveled and am familiar with a road in Grand County known as Bakers Reservoir Road. I knew the road as the Holding Pasture Road. I am also familiar with the land the road traverses. When I first used and observed the road in the early 1930s, it followed the same route as in 2007, when I last observed it. Attached is a Grand County map showing Bakers Reservoir Road. To the best of my knowledge and based upon my use of and familiarity with this road and the land it traverses, the location and route of the road are correctly illustrated on the attached map. The County also identifies this road according to the road number listed above.

3. I have observed that the road has been open to the public for all to use, to come and go as they pleased, since at least as early as the early 1930s and continuing through 1976 to 2007. Throughout this time period I have observed travel on the road by various means, including cars, cattle trucks, trucks and jeeps. Throughout this time

period, the road has been used daily from November to May, and less frequently during the rest of the year, more than ten continuous years prior to 1976, and was so used in 2007.


4. Throughout the time period from the early 1930s to 2007, I have used the road myself for livestock operations and traveling in and through the area.

5. Throughout the time period described in the previous paragraph, I observed vehicles using the road at various times for the uses described in the previous paragraph, plus hunting.






NEAL SWISHER, being first duly sworn, deposes and states as follows:

1. I am an adult competent to testify about the matters set forth below based upon my personal knowledge. I currently reside in Moab, Grand County, Utah. I have lived in Grand County since 1960. I worked in the oil fields of Grand County until I retired in the early 1990s.

2. I have traveled and am familiar with a road in Grand County known as Bakers Reservoir Road. I am also familiar with the land the road traverses. When I first used and observed the road in the early 1960s it followed the same route as in 2004 when I last observed it. Attached is a Grand County map showing Bakers Reservoir Road. To the best of my knowledge and based upon my use of and familiarity with this road and the land it traverses, the location and route of the road are correctly illustrated on the attached map.

3. The County also identifies this road according to the road number listed above.

4. I have observed that the road has been open to the public for all to use, to come and go as they pleased, since at least as early as the early 1960s and continuing through 2004. Throughout this time period I observed travel on the road by means of jeeps, pickup trucks and ATVs. During this time period, the road was used weekly for more than ten continuous years prior to 1976 and was used weekly in 2004.

5. Throughout the time period from the early 1960s to 2004, I used the road myself for oil field work, rock hounding and recreation.

6. Throughout the time period described in the previous paragraph, I have observed other vehicles from the general public using the road at various times for the uses described in the previous paragraph plus, livestock operations, hunting, prospecting for minerals, oil and gas exploration and sightseeing.



8. Prior to 1976, I observed road graders and heavy equipment performing maintenance and construction activities on the road.



Only those segments of the road that cross property owned and/or managed by an agency of the United States of America are considered candidates for consideration for status as R.S. 2477 rights of way. Actual status as 2477 rights of way is determined by their compliance with other requirements of the law. Initially, Notices of Acknowledgment of Acceptance of R.S. 2477 Right-of-Way Grants are being recorded by the State of Utah only for certain road segments that cross land managed by the U.S. Bureau of Land Management. Rights of way to roads that cross land managed by other agencies of the United States government are still being studied.
