When I first used and observed the road in the mid 1950s, it followed the same route as in 2001 when I last observed it. Attached is a Iron County map showing Horse Hollow Road. To the best of my knowledge and based upon my use of and familiarity with this road and the land it traverses, the location and route of the road are correctly illustrated on the attached map.
