TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS SHALL COME, Greeting:

Know ye, This is an Acknowledgment and Notice of Acknowledgment made under Utah Code Sections 72-5-309 through 310 inclusive, that the grant of the United States of America of “the right of way for the construction of highways over public lands, not reserved for public uses” under United States Revised Statutes 2477 (43 U.S.C. Section 932 (repealed October 21, 1976, with proviso recognizing the validity of rights-of-way already established)) was accepted for and on behalf of the State of Utah and its political subdivision Rich County as it pertains to the highway located in Rich County known as BIRCH CREEK RESERVOIR ROAD; County Road Number: BR56; State Geographic Information Database (SGID) Road Identification Number: RD170262. Total road length is 1.19 miles more or less.


The reason for this Acknowledgment and Notice of Acknowledgment includes, but is not limited to, the fact that the road was constructed, mechanically, or by continuous use as a public highway for a period of at least ten years, over public lands not reserved for public uses, prior to the earlier of (a) the October 21, 1976 repeal of R.S. 2477 or (b) the date the servient estate was reserved for public uses.

This Acknowledgment and Notice of Acknowledgment applies only to the segments of the road that traverse land owned by the Bureau of Land Management, United States Department of the Interior, and does not apply to segments of the road that traverse land owned by any other person or entity. The State of Utah and its political subdivisions reserve the right to make further acknowledgments and notices of acknowledgment with regard to road segments that traverse land owned by other entities, including the United States of America, through one or more of its agencies.

A printed copy of a map showing the location of the road in said county is appended hereto as “Attachment 1,” a printed copy of representative photos of the road is appended hereto as “Attachment 2,” a printed copy of a description of the beginning and ending points of the entire road together with a list of Townships, Ranges and Sections that may be traversed by the road in said county is appended hereto as “Attachment 3,” and a printed copy of the Road Centerline Description Cover Page(s) is appended hereto as “Attachment 4.” The Appendices listed in “Attachment 4” that contain the actual road centerline descriptions are incorporated herein by reference. Affidavits provided by individuals familiar with the road are appended hereto as “Attachment 5.”



GEORGE O. FRAZIER, being first duly sworn, deposes and states as follows:

1. I am an adult competent to testify about the matters set forth below based upon my personal knowledge. I currently reside in Rich County, Utah. I have lived in Rich County for 64 years.

2. I have traveled and am familiar with a road in Rich County known as Birch Creek Reservoir Road. I am also familiar with the land the road traverses. When I first used and observed the road in 1951, it followed the same route as in 2007 when I last observed it. Attached is a Rich County map showing Birch Creek Reservoir Road. To the best of my knowledge and based upon my use of and familiarity with this road and the land it traverses, the location and route of the road are correctly illustrated on the attached map.

3. I am informed that the County also identifies this road according to the road number listed above.

4. I have observed that the road has been open to the public for all to use, to come and go as they pleased, since at least as early as 1951 and continuing through 1976 to 2007. Throughout this time period I have observed travel on the road by various means, including cars, trucks, maintenance vehicles and jeeps. Throughout this time period, the road has been used daily, weather permitting, for more than ten continuous years prior to 1976, and was so used in 2007.

5. Throughout the time period from 1951 to 2007, I have used the road myself for

livestock operations, fishing, traveling in and through the area, hunting and camping.

6. Throughout the time period described in the previous paragraph, I have observed other vehicles from the general public using the road at various times for the uses described in the previous paragraph, plus prospecting for minerals, oil and gas exploration, tourism, recreation and government access.

7. It is also the reputation in the community that this road has been open to the public for all to use, to come and go as they pleased, since at least as early as the late 1800s and continuing through 1976 to the present, for the uses described in the previous paragraphs.


8. Prior to 1976, I observed graders performing maintenance and construction activities.




WESLEY TINGEY, being first duly sworn, deposes and states as follows:

1. I am an adult competent to testify about the matters set forth below based upon my personal knowledge. I currently reside in Rich County, Utah. I have lived in Rich County most of my life for the past 64 years.
2. I have traveled and am familiar with a road in Rich County known as Birch Creek Reservoir Road. I am also familiar with the land the road traverses. When I first used and observed the road in the early 1950s, it followed the same route as in 2007 when I last observed it. We went there for school picnics when I was a young boy. Attached is a Rich County map showing Birch Creek Reservoir Road. To the best of my knowledge and based upon my use of and familiarity with this road and the land it traverses, the location and route of the road are correctly illustrated on the attached map.
3. I am informed that the County also identifies this road according to the road number listed above.
4. I have observed that the road has been open to the public for all to use, to come and go as they pleased, since at least as early as the early 1950s and continuing through 1976 to 2007. Throughout this time period I have observed travel on the road by means of cars, trucks, cattle trucks, pickup trucks and ATVs. Throughout this time period, the road has been used daily, weather permitting for more than ten continuous years prior to 1976, and was so used in 2007.

5. Throughout the time period from the early 1950s to 2007, I have used the road myself for recreation, livestock operations, monitoring and operation of the reservoirs as president of the Woodruff Irrigation Company and fishing.

6. Throughout the time period described in the previous paragraph, I have observed other vehicles from the general public using the road at various times for the uses described in the previous paragraph, plus oil and gas exploration and hunting.

7. It is also the reputation in the community that this road has been open to the public for all to use, to come and go as they pleased, since at least as early as the early 1930s and continuing through 1976 to the present, for the uses described in the previous paragraphs.





