

1. I am an adult competent to testify about the matters set forth below based upon my personal knowledge. I currently reside in Glenwood, Sevier County, Utah. I have lived in Sevier County since 1933.
2. I have traveled and am familiar with a road in Sevier County known as the Lost Creek to Rex Reservoir Road. I am also familiar with the land the road traverses. When I first used and observed the road in 1960, it followed the same route as in 2006 when I last observed it. Attached is a Sevier County map showing the Lost Creek to Rex Reservoir Road. To the best of my knowledge and based upon my use of and familiarity with this road and the land it traverses, the location and route of the road are correctly illustrated on the attached map.
3. I am informed that the County also identifies this road according to the road number listed above.
4. I have observed that the road has been open to the public for all to use, to come and go as they pleased, since at least as early as 1960 and continuing through 1976 to 2006.
