When I first used and observed the road in the early 1960s, it followed the same route as in the 1990s, when I last observed it. Attached is a Uintah County map showing Kings Wells Road. To the best of my knowledge and based upon my use of and familiarity with this road and the land it traverses, the location and route of the road are correctly illustrated on the attached map.

3. I am informed that the County identifies this road according to the road number described above.

4. I have observed that the road has been open to the public for all to use, to come and go as they pleased, since at least as early as the early 1960s and continuing through 1976 to the 1990s. During this time period I have observed travel on the road by means of trucks and jeeps. During this time period, the road has been used daily.




8. I observed the following evidence of maintenance and construction activities on the road prior to 1976: I have personally observed the graded surface of the road.
