I, CLYDE R. NAYLOR, being first sworn, deposes and states as follows:

- I am an adult competent to testify about the matters set forth below based on my personal knowledge.
- My educational background includes a B.E.S. degree in Civil Engineering and M.S. degree in Structural Engineering, both from Brigham Young University.
- 3. I am currently a member of the American Public Works Association where I was the past chapter president and a past National Institute for Transportation Executive Council Member, a member of the American Society of Civil Engineers, and a member of the Utah Council of Land Surveyors.
- 4. I have been the Utah County Surveyor from January 1979 to December 31, 2006, the Utah County Engineer from January 1980 to the present, and the Utah County Public Works Director from January 1991 to the present. During these time periods, I have been personally familiar with Utah County's construction and maintenance activities on county roads, including the "B"road know as the Cedar Fort Diagonal Road that runs from State Road 73 westerly and northerly to the Cedar Fort Townsite. A map of the road is attached hereto as Exhibit "A".

- 5. The road is known as Utah County "B" road # B 831. The road is a chip sealed road located in Township 6 South, Range 2 West. The 0.19 miles length of the road, located in Section 7 of Township 6 South, Range 2 West runs across federal property.
- As the Utah County Surveyor, I have supervised a center line survey of the segment of the Cedar Fort Diagonal Road believed to be in the ownership of the Bureau of Land Management.

The center line description is as follows:

SEGMENT 1:

Commencing at the point of intersection of the centerline of the subject road with the North line of Section 7, Township 6 South, Range 2 West, Salt Lake Base and Meridian; said point being more specifically described as being located West 736.27 feet and North 0.97 feet from the Northeast Corner of said Section 7; thence the following along the said subject road centerline: South 09° 40' 56" East 204.30 feet; South 08° 37' 16" East 491.20 feet; South 08° 34' 08" East 308.83 feet to the intersection with State lands as described and recorded under Deed #24391-85.

- 7. Pursuant to Utah Code Ann. § 17-23-1 and during the time I served as the Utah County Surveyor, I was the designated record holder for all the surveys and maps made within the county. The records of the Utah County Surveyor show that the road has existed since 1955, and has been utilized and maintained as a county "B" road since that time. The attached copies of documents taken from the Utah County Surveyor's records identify the roads existence:
 - The General Highway Map of Utah County, dated 1955, prepared by the Utah Department of Transportation, shows the Cedar Fort Diagonal as a

county road used to access the south end of the Town of Cedar Fort, which is attached hereto as Exhibit "A1".

- b. The general highway map of Utah County, dated 1958, prepared by the
 Utah Department of Transportation, shows the existence of the road,
 which is attached hereto as Exhibit "A2".
- c. The United State Government survey map for Cedar Fort, Utah dated1968, shows the road, which is attached as Exhibit "A3".
- d. The Official County Road Map of Utah County for Township 6 South,
 Range 2 West, adopted by the Utah County Commission on April 28, 1980
 shows the road, which is attached hereto as Exhibit "A4".
- e. The Road Map of Utah County, Sheet # 4, created November 21, 1995, shows the relationship the road has with the federal property in the area, which is attached as Exhibit "A5".
- f. The official County Road Map of Utah County, Sheet #4, adopted by the Board of County Commissioners on October 30, 1996, shows the road running across the federal properties, which is attached as Exhibit "A6".
- g. The current County Atlas, page 36, titled Cedar Fort, shows the Cedar Fort Diagonal Road as it traverses federal property, which is attached as Exhibit "A7".
- h. The surveyed description for Segment 01 of the Cedar Fort Diagonal Road has been plotted on an Aerial Photo taken in 1993 to verify the roads existence and is attached as Exhibit "A8".

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- At no time during my tenure with the County did it undertake any procedure to abandon 8. or vacate its right-of-way on the road.
- 9. I have had the County records searched for any evidence of reservations on this road and none have been found.

I, ROBERT CURTIS BEVERLY, being first duly sworn, deposes and state as follows:

- I am adult competent to testify about the matters set forth below based on my personal knowledge.
- 2. From 1958 to 1988, I was employed with Utah County in the Roads Department where I was an operator/truck driver, supervisor over bridges and culverts, and worked in maintenance and oiling of roads. During that time period, I was personally familiar with Utah County's construction and maintenance activities on county roads, including the road known as Cedar Fort Diagonal that runs from State Road 73 westerly and northerly to the Cedar Fort Townsite. A map of the road is attached hereto as Exhibit "A".
- 3. Construction and maintenance of the road before 1976 was performed by road graders and other road equipment in addition to the passing of motorized vehicles over the roadway. While working with the Utah County Public Works Department Road Division throughout the 1950's and 1960's I helped maintain the road using graders and other road equipment.
- All acts of the County regarding this road were, to my knowledge, consistent with its status as a public highway.
- The road has been open to the public for all to use, to come and go as they pleased, since before 1950 and continuing through 1976 and beyond.
- 6. Since before 1950 and continuing to the present the road has been used for ranching, farming, hunting, homesteading, commerce, sightseeing, search and rescue, law enforcement, land management, accessing state school and institutional trust lands, and traveling in and

through the area. At least as early as 1950, while working for the Utah County Public Works Department Roads Division, I often traveled the road performing road maintenance.

- The road has been open to the public for all to use, to come and go as they pleased, since before 1950 and continuing through 1976 and beyond.
- Travelers on the road from before 1950 and continuing thereafter included those who went by car, recreational vehicle, and truck. The frequency of use over the period 1966 to the present is approximately daily.
- 9. When I first used and observed the road it ran the same route as it does now, and the road was well established as of 1966.
- 10. At no time during my employment with the County did it undertake any procedures to abandon or vacate its right-of-way on the road.

- 2. From 1947 to 1965, I was employed with Utah Department of Transportation in District 6 where I was a truck operator, a foremen, and supervisor. From 1965 to 1985 I was employed with Utah County in the Roads Department where I was an assistant supervisor and supervisor over the Roads Department. During that time period, I was personally familiar with Utah County's construction and maintenance activities on county roads, including the road known as Cedar Fort Diagonal that runs from State Road 73 westerly and northerly to the Cedar Fort Townsite. A map of the road is attached hereto as Exhibit "A".
- 3. Construction and Maintenance of the road before 1947 was performed by road graders and other road equipment in addition to the passing of motorized vehicles over the roadway. In more recent time, though still before 1976, the road was paved and maintained by snow plows.
