I, CLYDE R. NAYLOR, being first sworn, deposes and states as follows:

- I am an adult competent to testify about the matters set forth below based on my personal knowledge.
- My educational background includes a B.E.S. degree in Civil Engineering and M.S. degree in Structural Engineering, both from Brigham Young University.
- 3. I am currently a member of the American Public Works Association where I was the past chapter president and a past National Institute for Transportation Executive Council Member, a member of the American Society of Civil Engineers, and a member of the Utah Council of Land Surveyors.
- 4. I have been the Utah County Surveyor from January 1979 to December 31, 2006, the Utah County Engineer from January 1980 to the present, and the Utah County Public Works Director from January 1991 to the present. During these time periods, I have been personally familiar with Utah County's construction and maintenance activities on county roads, including the "B"road know as the Kyune Pass Road that runs from U. S. Highway 6 easterly to Carbon County. A map of the road is attached hereto as Exhibit "A".

- 5. The road is known as Utah County "B" road # B 883. The road is an asphalt road located in Township 11 South, Range 9 East. The 1.32 miles length of the road, located in Sections 34 and 35 of Township 11 South, Range 9 East runs across federal property.
- 6. As the Utah County Surveyor, I have supervised a center line survey of the segment of the Kyune Pass Road believed to be in the ownership of the Bureau of Land Management.

 The center line description is as follows:

SEGMENT 2:

Commencing at the point of intersection of the centerline of the Kyune Pass Road with the South boundary of Section 35, Township 11 South, Range 9 East, Salt Lake Base and Meridian, said point being more specifically described as being located 4.71 feet South and 1787.91 feet East from the Southwest Corner of said Section 35; thence the following along the said centerline: North 55° 12' 58" West 1542.12 feet; North 54° 12' 11" West 384.05 feet; North 47° 56' 35" West 129.41 feet; North 41° 08' 38" West, 421.38 feet; North 47° 54' 46" West 94.86 feet; North 54° 25' 40" West 137.84 feet; North 60° 29' 53" West 145.08 feet; North 68° 16' 41" West 180.73 feet; North 69° 38' 31" West 418.44 feet; North 69° 57' 55" West 651.90 feet; North 70° 34' 21" West 333.55 feet; North 73° 44' 15" West 302.94 feet; North 76° 40' 12" West 336.99 feet; North 80° 06' 59" West 253.56 feet; North 82° 18' 11" West 200.83 feet; North 84° 57' 33" West 350.69 feet; North 87° 44' 45" West 1085.23 feet.

7. Pursuant to Utah Code Ann. § 17-23-1 and during the time I served as the Utah County Surveyor, I was the designated record holder for all the surveys and maps made within the county. The records of the Utah County Surveyor show that the road has existed since

1910, and has been utilized and maintained as a county "B" road since that time. The attached copies of documents taken from the Utah County Surveyor's records identify the roads existence:

- a. The road map of Utah County, dated January 31, 1910, prepared by Frank Wentz, County Surveyor, shows the location of the road within Sections 34 and 35 of Township 11 South, Range 9 east, which is attached hereto as Exhibit "A1".
- b. The Utah County map of 1924, prepared by Ed B. Jones, County Surveyor, shows the location of the road within Sections 34 and 35 of Township 11 South, Range 9 east, which is attached hereto as Exhibit "A2".
- c. The Utah County map prepared by L. D. Green, County Surveyor, and revised in September of 1966, shows the county road, which is attached hereto as Exhibit "A3".
- d. The United States Government survey map for Kyune, Utah dated 1969, shows the location of the road, which is attached hereto as Exhibit "A4".
- e. The general highway map of Utah County, prepared by the Utah State

 Department of Highways, dated 1975, shows the "B" road as a county road located between U. S. Highway 6 and the Carbon County line, which is attached hereto as Exhibit "A5".

- f. The general highway map of Utah County prepared by the Utah

 Department of Transportation, dated 1985, shows the county road, which
 is attached as Exhibit "A6".
- g. The Road Map of Utah County, Sheet # 17, created November 21, 1995, shows the relationship the road has with the federal property in the area, which is attached as Exhibit "A7".
- The current County Atlas, page 20, titled Price River, shows the Kyune
 Pass Road as it traverses federal property, which is attached as Exhibit
 "A8".
- i. The surveyed description for Segment 02 of the Kyune Pass Road has been plotted on an Aerial Photo taken in 1993 to verify the roads existence and is attached as Exhibit "A9".
- 8. At no time during my tenure with the County did it undertake any procedure to abandon or vacate its right-of-way on the road.
- I have had the County records searched for any evidence of reservations on this road and none have been found.





I, ROBERT CURTIS BEVERLY, being first duly sworn, deposes and states as follows:

- I am an adult competent to testify about the matters set forth below based on my personal knowledge.
- 2. From 1958 to 1988 I was employed with Utah County in the Roads Department where I was an operator/truck driver, supervisor over bridges and culverts, and worked in maintenance and oiling of roads. During that time period, I was personally familiar with Utah County's construction and maintenance activities on county roads, including the road known as Kyune Pass Road [Emma Park Road] that runs from U.S. Highway 6 about 1.5 miles toward the Carbon County line. A map of the road is attached hereto as Exhibit "A".
- 3. Utah County has performed the following maintenance activities on the road during my employment with the County: skin patched and pothole patched the road, performed other general maintenance on the road during the summer, and personally inspected the bridges along the road with the State of Utah.
- The road has also been called the White River Road because the bridges cross the White River which flows out of Strawberry Reservoir.
- 5. All acts of the County regarding this road were, to my knowledge, consistent with its status as a public highway.
- 6. It is the reputation in the community that this road was used by the public since at least as

- early as 1958, and has been continuously used since that time.
- 7. At no time during my employment with the County undertake any procedure to abandon or vacate its right-of-way on the road.
- 8. Uses of the road since before 1966 and before any federal reservation included, but were not limited to, providing a shortcut to Duchesne, Utah from the Provo, Utah area.



During that time period, I was personally familiar with Utah County's construction and maintenance activities on county roads, including the road known as Kyune Pass Road [Emma Park Road] that runs from U.S. Highway 6 about 1.5 miles toward the Carbon County line. A map of the road is attached hereto as Exhibit "A".
- Utah County has performed the following maintenance activities on the road during my employment with the County: patched the road, sealed the road, and performed other general maintenance on the road.
- 4. All acts of the County regarding this road were, to my knowledge, consistent with its status as a public highway.
- 5. It is the reputation in the community that this road was used by the public since at least as early as 1947, and has been continuously used since that time. I first used the road when I worked for the state. For a while the state maintained the road when they were rebuilding

Price Canyon.

- At no time during my employment with the County undertake any procedure to abandon or vacate its right-of-way on the road.
- 7. Uses of the road since before 1966 and before any federal reservation included, but were not limited to, sheepherding, ranching, and providing a shortcut to Willow Creek and Duchesne, Utah from the Provo, Utah area.


